### Location

Located mid-way between Alice Springs and Uluru (Ayers Rock), Watarrka National Park covers 71,000 hectares and is home to Kings Canyon. The Resort is situated just 9km from the Canyon.

- Just 3 hours drive from Uluru (Ayers Rock) and 4 hours from Alice Springs

## ACCESS

### Air

Via Alice Springs or Ayers Rock Airports (Qantas & Virgin Blue). Flights are available daily from major cities within Australia including Adelaide, Brisbane, Broome, Cairns, Darwin, Perth, Melbourne and Sydney. Private landing for small aircraft available at Kings Creek Station, 40km from the Resort. Shuttle service available.

### Coach Transfers

AAT Kings and APT provide coach transfers from Ayers Rock and Alice Springs daily.

### Self Drive

Self drive is a popular option. From Alice, 4WD vehicles may choose the spectacular Mereenie / Larapinta Loop Road or Ernest Giles Road.

For an all-sealed option, follow the Stuart Highway, Lasseters Highway and Luritja Road. From Ayers Rock Resort, follow Lasseters Highway before turning onto Luritja Road.
